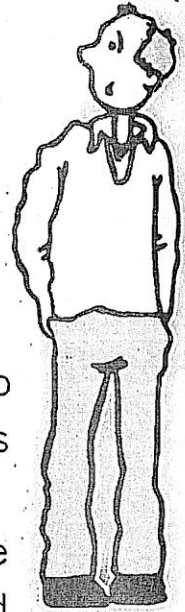
Read the following story and then answer the questions in **COMPLETE** sentences.
