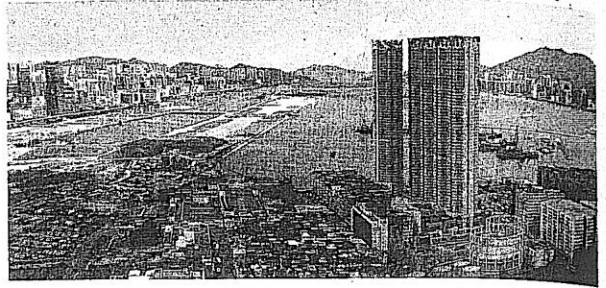


**Part I (Reading Comprehension)** (15 marks, 3 marks each)
