CHAPTER CHECKLIST

- Notes are just for you; no one else needs to understand them.
 - The goal of note-taking is to record information quickly and clearly.
 - The purpose of notes is to help you maintain your structure, not to determine every word you say.
 - Flowing can help you see the arguments that run through the debate.
 - A debater should maintain two sets of notes: one to record the round, the other to organize her speech.
 - Debaters should not read their notes aloud during their speech.
 - Annotate the entire debate for later reference.
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
